Aggregated Geographies



- The population in this area is estimated to change from 1,444 to 1,440, resulting in a decline of -0.3% between 2000 and the current year. Over the next five years, the population is projected to grow by 0.3%.
 - The population in the United States is estimated to change from 281,421,906 to 290,647,163, resulting in a growth of 3.3% between 2000 and the current year. Over the next five years, the population is projected to grow by 5.3%.

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
