Garbage cans will have plastic bags in place. You are responsible for removing the garbage bags and placing them in the nearby dumpster. You must place a new bag in the garbage can. New bags are located in the bottom of the can. If the dumpster is full and your bag won't fit, you must take it to the next closest dumpster or take the trash with you.
Be sure to turn off any lights in the shelter prior to leaving.
The Village crew will have the shelter and surrounding area clean prior to your event and will inspect it the same day following your event. Assuming the shelter and surrounding area meet the above requirements your security deposit will be returned to you at the address indicated on the reservation form.
