Chapter 113

PROPERTY, DISPOSAL OF

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Village Board of the Village of Spring Green as § 2.14 of the Village Code. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 113-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meaning indicated:

PERSONAL PROPERTY — Includes all goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, and effects of any nature or description having any real or marketable value and not included in the term "real property" as defined in § 70.03, Wis. Stats.

§ 113-2. Disposal procedure.

Any item of personal property which is found by the Village Clerk-Treasurer and head of the department responsible for the item to be unnecessary for future use by the Village shall be disposed of as follows:

- A. Personal property to be disposed of shall be advertised in The Home News for sale either by auction or by sealed bid how, when and in the manner the Village Clerk-Treasurer shall determine.
- B. At the time of the auction or at the time of the opening of the sealed bids, the item of personal property being disposed of shall be sold for cash to the highest bidder unless a minimum bid has been designated and not met.

§ 113-3. Exceptions.

This chapter shall not apply to:

- A. Personal property that is traded in as part of the purchase of comparable replacement personal property.
- B. The sale of personal property subject to disposal pursuant to procedures and requirements of the State of Wisconsin or United States.

§ 113-4. Sales to Village employees.

The provisions of § 175.10, Wis. Stats., restricting sales to employees of the Village shall apply to sales under this chapter.
