1. **Call to order and attendance:** Jane Hauser called the meeting to order at 5:36 p.m.

2. **Appoint minute taker:** Crary appointed minute taker.
3. **Read and approve minutes of the September 29, 2021 Joint Meeting of the Sanitation & Recycling Committee and the Town of Spring Green:** Robson moved and Miller seconded to approve the minutes of the September 29, 2021 Joint Meeting of the Sanitation & Recycling Committee and the Town of Spring Green. Motion passed with all in favor.
4. **Review and approve agenda:** Radel moved and Carmody seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed with all in favor.
5. **Discussion and possible action regarding Kennedy Road Recycling Center/Burn Area Agreement – Attachment A revisions.** Crary reviewed the adjusted hourly rates and changes for the Village. Robson informed all in attendance what the updated rates for the Township should be. Crary will update the information and forward to the Town of Spring Green. No action was necessary regarding the Kennedy Road Recycling Center/Burn Area Agreement – Attachment A. Revisions will be reviewed at an upcoming Town of Spring Green and Village of Spring Green Board Meeting for approval by each municipality.

With this being permitted/allowed both municipalities will no longer need to pay for ashes to be disposed of through Town & Country Sanitation. This will save a significant amount of money for both municipalities as the cost for disposal was the majority of the expenses associated with the facility.
