## Park & Recreation Committee Meeting Minutes Tuesday, July 19, 2022 Meeting held via Zoom & Teleconference 7:00 p.m.

- 1. **Call to Order and Attendance:** David Saperstein called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Committee members present: David Saperstein, Jennifer Snow, and Debra Miller. Also present was Wendy Crary, Adam Reno, and Todd Deibert.
- 2. **Appoint Minute Taker:** Crary was appointed minute taker.
- 3. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Snow, second by Miller to approve minutes from the February 23, 2022 Park & Recreation Committee Meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.
- 4. **Approve Agenda:** Motion by Miller, second by Snow to approve the agenda. Motion passed with all in favor.
- 5. Discussion and possible action regarding updating Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (CORP) for the Village of Spring Green. Saperstein reviewed what was discussed at the previous meeting. The Committee discussed how best to proceed with a public input meeting. Deibert explained to all in attendance how Jewell Associates holds open house style public informational meetings for street projects.
