- 3. Motion by Saperstein, second by Zimmer, to approve agenda. Motion passed with all in favor.
- 4. Consideration of a request by John Houck for a conditional use permit for Motor Vehicle Sales on parcel #182-0875-00000, Lot 15 Sunrise Drive, Village of Spring Green. Kuhse expressed his concerns regarding used car sales.
